## E-Learning Calendar Highlights

- E-Learning will continue this week on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, March 23 - 25, with regular 45-minute lessons. Teachers are making a renewed effort to limit lessons to that length so as to account for the many priorities scholars and families are juggling.
- Thursday, March 26 will be an E-Learning C-day with no new assignments but a chance for students to wrap up and catch up on any work from the first two weeks.
- Spring Break starts on Friday, March 27 and will now extend for students until Wednesday, April 8.
- Monday and Tuesday, April 6 and 7, will be teacher work days to prepare lessons for April E-Learning.
