Test Access:

48 hours before a scheduled exam, students will receive an email with an Exam E-Ticket. Students will also be able to access your E-Tickets through their CB account if needed. You can access your College Board Account at <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org>

Test Start Times:

Please note that students should log into their test 30 minutes before the scheduled start time. For example, if an exam is scheduled for 2:00pm, students should log in at 1:30.

Exam Demo:

The College Board will release a testing demo on May 4th that can be found at the link below. This demo will not be course specific but will focus on the process for uploading responses. You can practice with this as many times as you would like.

The demo also serves as a technology check. If students are able to access the demo then they should be able to access the test on testing day. Students must use Chrome, Safari, Edge, or Firefox. Internet Explorer will not be supported. Plugins such as Grammarly should be disabled
